East Hoosac Preyarative Meeting was estublished between 1778 and 1783 by Suratoga (later called Baston) Monthly Meeting. At Nine Partners Wonthly Meeting 11th.mo. 19, 1773, a communication from Smithfield Monthly Meeting (in Rhode Island) informs that some of their members. It deat Hooseck, desires pertificates to Oblong or Vine Partneps M.H. and asks to which M.H. they should belong, Committee appointed to reply. 1st.mo.21,1774, Smithfield W.W. desires our care For East Hoosack Friends, which is approved. This transferred their membership to Nine Partners E.M. Sth.mo. 20, 1774, Dartmouth (Mass.) M.M. informs that "Divers of their meeting have Removed and are about to remove to Saratoga and desire our answer whether or no said Place is under our Care." Hast Hoosack Friends request a meeting 9th.mo. 16,1774, which was allowed 10th.mo. 21,1774, at the house of Issac Killy, This meeting for worship, composed of Friends from Smithfield, R. I. and Bartmouth, Vass., was a part of Wine Partners W.H. until Saratoga (later called Easton) M.M. was set off therefrom 6th.mo.11,1776. When Mart Hoosack Youthly Meeting was set off from Easton Monthly Meeting, East Hoosack Preparative Mesting was the one Preparative Mesting it comprised, and it never had another.
