Statement by John Cox Jr. of New York City  
regarding early Quaker records, Apr. 19, 1920.

East Hoosack Preparative Meeting was established between 1773 and 1783 by Saratoga (later called Easton) Monthly Meeting. At Nine Partners Monthly Meeting 11th.mo.19,1773,a communication from Smithfield Monthly Meeting (in Rhode Island) informs that some of their members at East Hoosack, desires certificates to Oblong or Nine Partners M.M. and asks to which M.M. they should belong. Committee appointed to reply. 1st.mo.21,1774,Smithfield M.M. desires our care for East Hoosack Friends,which is approved. This transferred their membership to Nine Partners M.M. 3th.mo.20,1774,Dartmouth (Mass.) M.M informs that "Divers of their meeting have Removed and are about to remove to Saratoga and desire our answer whether or no said Place is under our Care." East Hoosack Friends request a meeting 9th.mo.16,1774,which was allowed 10th.mo.21,1774,at the house of Issac Killy, This meeting for worship,composed of Friends from Smithfield,R.I. and Dartmouth,Vass.,was a part of Nine Partners M.M. until Saratoga (later called Easton) M.M. was set off therefrom 6th.mo.11,1776. When East Hoosack Monthly Meeting was set off from Easton Monthly Meeting,East Hoosack Preparative Meeting was the one Preparative Meeting it comprised,and it never had another.


